

Hospitals lose. Drug companies cash in

A Virginia budget amendment to remove 340B drugs from Medicaid coverage at hospitals is being sold as state savings — but most of the money flows to drug companies, in discounts they used to give safety-net hos..

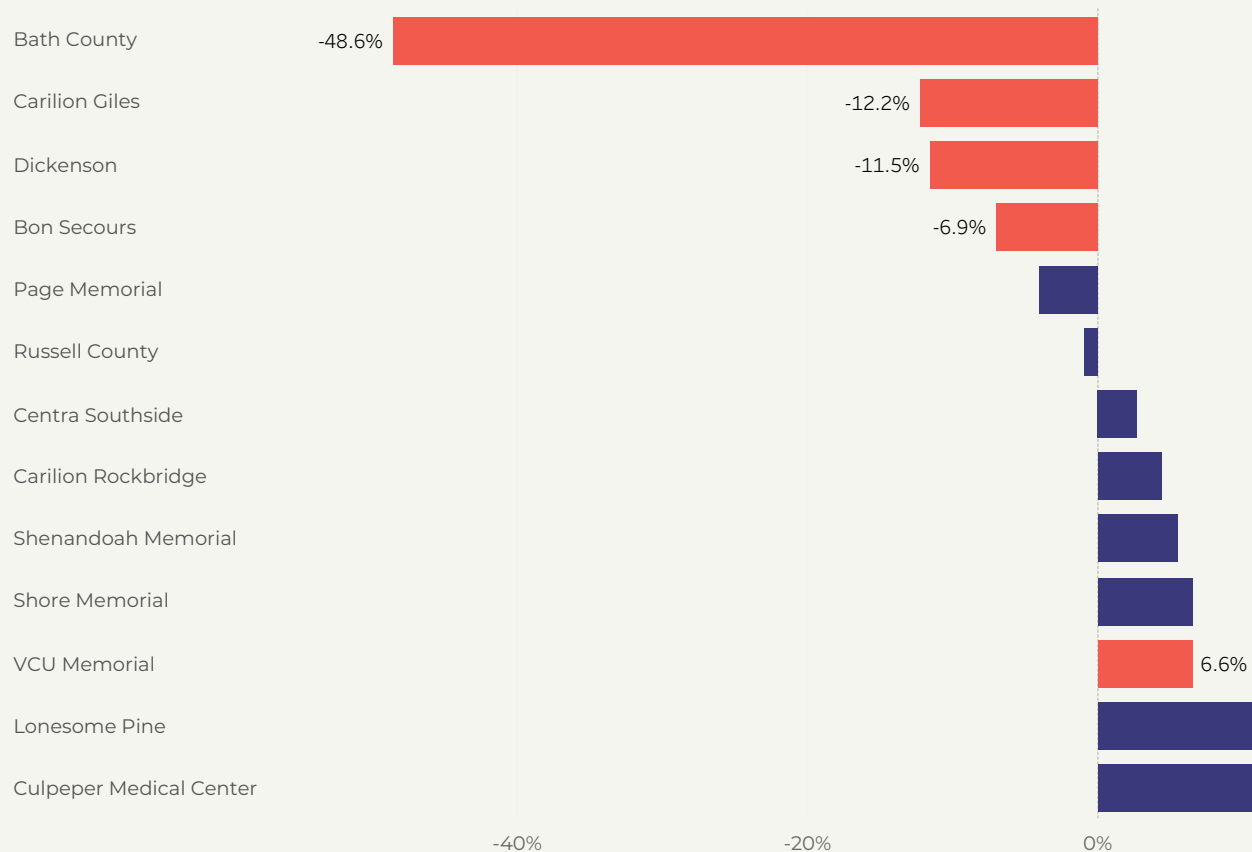
